Commander Eric Quigley reported to USCGC KIMBALL (WMSL 756) as Executive Officer in May 2024 after completing a two-year assignment as the Executive Assistant to the Director of Governmental and Public Affairs (CG-092) at Coast Guard Headquarters where he provided support to the Director in the executive management of enterprise-wide policy, guidance, and program management for Public Affairs, Congressional Affairs, Governmental and Tribal Affairs, External Outreach, and Coast Guard Heritage.

Commander Quigley is a career Cutterman with previous shipboard assignments as Deck Watch Officer aboard USCGC DAUNTLESS (WMEC 624) in Galveston, TX, Executive Officer aboard USCGC GALVESTON ISLAND (WPB 1349) in Honolulu, HI, Executive Officer aboard USCGC WILLOW (WLB 202) in Newport, RI, and Commanding Officer of USCGC MOBILE BAY (WTGB 103 & CGB 12002) in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin, where he led a crew of 30 responsible for servicing over 100 Aids to Navigation in Lake Michigan and conducting domestic icebreaking operations and law enforcement operations throughout the Great Lakes.



Commander Quigley's other Headquarters assignments include the Deputy for Living Marine Resources Enforcement Policy Division in the Office of Maritime Law Enforcement overseeing the execution the Coast Guard's domestic and international fisheries enforcement missions and the Aids to Navigation and Icebreaker Platform Sponsor in the Office of Cutter Forces in Washington, D.C.

Commander Quigley, a native of Green Bay, WI, graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in New London, CT in 2006, where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Management. He attended the University of North Carolina Wilmington and earned a Master of Science Degree in Coastal and Ocean Policy in 2016.
