Commander Farr currently serves as Deputy Sector Commander, U.S. Coast Guard Sector Anchorage on Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER), Alaska. As the Deputy, he assists the Sector Commander in planning, organizing and leading the Sector.
