Master Chief Katchko assumed the duties as the Reserve Command Master Chief of Coast Guard Port Security Unit 309, Port Clinton, OH in August 2019. In this role he serves as the senior enlisted leader and advisor to the Command on all matters impacting the enlisted workforce and their families.

Master Chief Katchko's previous assignments include Sector Buffalo Reserve Command Master Chief, Sector Delaware Bay Incident Management Division, Station Philadelphia (plank owner), Marine Safety Office Philadelphia, Group Philadelphia Operations & Boat Operations Divisions, and USCGC LAUREL WLB 291 Mayport, FL. He has held numerous positions at these units, to include; Reserve Command Master Chief, Senior Enlisted Reserve Advisor, Officer of the Day, Tactical Coxswain, Boarding Officer, and Pollution Responder.
